The women held monthly circle meetings with an average total attendance of 20. The duties entailed serving young people, keeping the nursery, and placing flowers in the church on Sundays. The ladies provided the men with covered dish suppers before their meetings, helped with the Christmas party, staffed vacation Church School, sponsored a Girl Scout troop, and participated in the Least Coin Fellowship. The white Cross quota was met, a Joy Gift supper was held in December, and Blessing Boxes were received twice during the year. Miss Catherine Newton, incoming Presbyterial President was guest speaker at the annual Birthday Party held May 2. Before Christmas the women mailed gifts and food to men in service. The Church world Service shipment came to 84 pounds.
