#### WOMEN OF THE CHURCH

On three Sunday nights in February and March the women participated in the mission study programs which were presented in three different classes to the entire congregation. The World Missions offering totaled \$46.46.

On March first the women were hostesses to the church Women United of Winder-Barrow County for the World Day of Prayer service. Clothing for Church World Service was packed and sent in two shipments of 76 lbs. and 125 lbs. Six sheets were sent to White Cross to be used in Brazil.

The Birthday Party was held in May with the offering of \$22.50 going to TRAV. On five Sunday nights in April and May, the Women sponsored a church-wide Bible School under the leadership of Mrs. W. E. Parker.

An evening circle and a morning circle were held each month for the women to have Bible study and fellowship. At Thanksgiving the WOC gathered together foodstuffs and presented them to a needy family. During the Christmas season they bought toys and took them to children of an underprivileged family.
